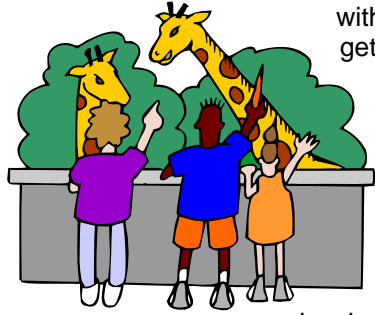


MONDAY, JUNE 15, 2009
